# Adult Sunday School & Small Groups






# **UMCOR**

September 2020, our Network has responded to 21 requests. What Child is this, who, laid to rest, On Mary's lap is sleeping? Whom angels greet with anthems sweet, While shepherds watch are keeping?

Chorus:

"What Child is This?" was written in 1865 by Englishman William Chatterton Dix, who underwent a spiritual renewal during a severe illness. Each stanza is a progression – the words start by asking about the divinity of baby Jesus and finish by praising his name.

"Today in the town of David a Savior has been born to you; he is the Messiah, the Lord. 12 This will be a sign to you: You will find a baby wrapped in cloths and lying in a manger." 13 Suddenly a great company of the heavenly host appeared with the angel, praising God and saying, 14 "Glory to God in the highest heaven, and on earth peace to those on whom his favor rests."" Luke 2:11-14
