FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Holidays

Christmas is coming!

The celebration of the birth of our Lord is always a high and holy time in the life of the church. There are many events happening in this season, so be sure to keep up to date with the bulletin and the church app.

And please remember that this is a great time for evangelism. You have neighbors and friends who don't go to church anywhere, but might consider visiting in this season if invited. It is a great season to welcome someone new.



In particular, remember three special services.

Dec 18. There will be a special choir presentation at the 8:30 and 11 services with no preaching. The middle service at 9:45 will have preaching. So, in the past, many people have attended two services.

Dec 24. We will host two candlelight Christmas Eve services. The main service will be at 6:30 pm and then we will continue with our third year of the "Almost Midnight Service" at 11.

Dec 25. This year, Christmas Day falls on a Sunday and we will have one combined worship service in the Main Sanctuary at 10:30.

Disaffiliation

I wanted to share just a couple of quick updates. On Nov 9, our Administrative Council voted unanimously to move to a final Disaffiliation vote. That vote will be in early March of 2023.

The Council also established a Disaffiliation fund to receive gifts with the understanding that if we do not Disaffiliate, then the donor may have the option of having money returned since it was given for that purpose. I have already been approached by someone who wants to make a special gift toward Disaffiliation. The cost is significant, and any gifts can help.

Our Long Range Planning Committee received about 50 suggestions for a name if we Disaffiliate. They narrowed that list down to 5 (thanks to all who submitted suggestions and to the Committee for their good work). That list will be presented in the future and church members will get to vote on what name they prefer. I envision a Sunday Townhall meeting sometime in late January to vote on a possible name if we should Disaffiliate.

Our Long Range Planning Committee was also tasked with researching possible Methodist denominations our church might join should we Disaffiliate. They have done that work and presented their findings at a Townhall meeting at the end of October. They recommended our congregation join the Global Methodist Church as a good fit for this church. 
