At the beginning of the school year in August we gave teachers in our congregation a \$50 gift card for them to use for supplies for the coming year.

We also gave the Wesley Child center platters of fruit ,cheese and vegetables to start their new school year.

In November we gave out 30 boxes of food for Thanksgiving to clients that we had seen this year.

In December we are giving out presents from our Angel Tree to needy families with children. We were overwhelmed at the response to the angel tree. Every tag was taken the first day. When we put out a few more on the Sunday those were snatched up too. We ended up helping 31 families and the storage room with the presents is overflowing Everyone that helped gave generously and many children in Crestview will have a very blessed Christmas because of you all.


