Lent to Resurrection

We had a large gathering for our special Ash Wednesday Service to begin the season of Lent. Young and older gathered to draw near to the Lord in this time of searching and preparation.

As we move toward our Resurrection Celebration at the end of March, please note all of the special events and worship services.



Holy Week begins with a church-wide celebration

on Palm Sunday, March 24. As per our tradition, on that day we will have one combined worship service in the Main Sanctuary at 10:30 AM. After worship, we will have dinner on the grounds with activities for children including their egg hunt.

We then move to Maundy Thursday Holy Communion with worship at 6:30 PM.

On Good Friday (Mar 29) at 6:30 PM we will once again host a Tenebrae service of Shadows. This service is structured around music and the Scriptures of Jesus' last hours before the tomb. If you have never attended this service, you honestly need to come. Many people have told me it is one of the most moving worship services they have attended. I sincerely believe that those who attend this service have a greater sense of the power of Easter Sunday morning.

Our Resurrection Celebration will be on March 31 at all three worship services at their usual times of 8:30, 9:45 and 11 AM. Please invite a friend to come worship with you. Easter is one of the main times of year that people are most receptive to an invitation. Invite them to come, and then sit with them when they come!

A Health Concern

A few parishioners have commented on my frequent drinking of water while I preach. I decided I would let the church know that I am indeed struggling. Normally, I would not use this forum to talk about something like this- but honestly, it is a bit distracting (at least for me, if not for you).

Since sometime before last Thanksgiving, my mouth has been excessively dryand as you can imagine, not only is that a challenge for everyday life, but it especially hinders public speaking. There are moments in preaching when my mouth is so dry, I cannot speak well. My words will slur. This is why I simply have to take a sip- and I hope you will bear with me. It is obviously a challenge to get through three services with this going on. I also wanted you to know that my hearing has greatly degraded. Whether it is the same problem or a different one, I don't currently know. Ever since I flew up to see grandchildren in December, my ears never equalized. I have worn hearing aides the whole time you have known me (most people don't even notice), but lately, I have had to turn them almost all the way up in order to understand people. So, if I am having trouble hearing you- know that it is me, and not you.

Like many people, I'm not very big on talking about my health issues with others, but in this case, I thought you should know since it has been negatively impacting my ministry.By the time you read this I'll have visited with a doctor or two. Thank you for your prayers and your patience. I do know this: God's grace is sufficient for each and every need.
