

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Prayer

In the book of Revelation, a work filled with symbolic language, we find a powerful image in chapter 8.

In chapters 5 through 8, there is a scroll sealed with seven seals which only Jesus is worthy to open. A seal is broken and then something happens- some action or event.

In chapter 8, the last seal is broken and the action takes place in Heaven. At first there is silence, and then we have symbolism which comes from Temple worship. A messenger of God is given a "censer" which is a kind of scoop or bowl. Incense is placed in the censer along with fire (hot coals) from the altar of God. This of course makes smoke. The messenger then hurls the smoking, burning censer at the earth. The result is that the earth is shaken.



And here's the point of this image and the heart of the symbolism: we're told one extra ingredient is mixed with the incense- the prayers of the people of God. The fire is from God, the prayers are from the people. And mixed together, the world is shaken. No wonder the early Christians were so convinced that prayer is the privilege and obligation of the Church, but also that prayer makes a difference!

There are many opportunities to live out our calling to pray.

Pray *Individually*. At home, at work, while driving. Be a person of prayer. Our church office sends out a prayer list every week by email. If you're not getting it, please let the church office know.

Pray in *Groups*. Join your voice with others in calling to the One who sits on the throne.

Every Wednesday morning at 9 AM, there are two groups who meet for prayer. Women meet in the prayer room just down the carpet from the main office. Men meet in the Conference Room down the uncarpeted hall of the office wing.

And there are still other groups, classes and meetings where prayer happens.

There are also city gatherings. An ecumenical prayer group with people from churches all across the Crestview area meets to pray. They are called the *Crestview Prayer Network*. We advertise their meetings in our bulletin. Currently they meet at lunch at a restaurant on the first Wednesday of the month.

The first Thursday in May (May 2) has been set aside as the *National Day of Prayer*. There will be a city-wide prayer event on that day where pastors from around Crestview will lift up prayers. This year it will be held at the gazebo near the Courthouse in downtown Crestview at 6 PM. You may wish to bring your own seating.

Furthermore, as we've done for the last few years, our *Main Sanctuary* will be open for prayer on the National Day of Prayer. This is a come-and-go time for people to pray. Stations will be set up around the Sanctuary providing prompts for prayer. Start at the altar and then moved around the Sanctuary. The Main Sanctuary will be open from 9:30 AM until 3 PM.

Mayor Whitten invites our citizens to a the *Mayor's Prayer Breakfast* on May 30 from 7:30 – 9 AM (doors open at 7). People have graciously donated to make the event possible. Because seating is limited, reservations are required by calling 850-682-3812. Special guest speaker will be Clint Purvis, the Florida State University Team Chaplain.


