These mugs really are unique and eyecatching... but that's because our stained glass is so beautiful.

We are currently taking orders for #2 and we will be placing the order soon. The samples are in the glass case in the lobby near the office. I'm not sure if we will be taking orders for #3 before Christmas, but it is possible.
